課程描述 Course Description					
This course is designed to provide students with an understanding of the spirit, meaning, philosophy, process, and methodology of academic research, with particular emphasis on the development of problem solving, root cause exploration, logical thinking, and methodological application. The objectives of the course are to stimulate students' interest in academic research, to familiarize them with the writing of doctoral dissertations, and to enable them to propose research topics for their doctoral dissertations after the course, as well as to explain the contribution and innovativeness of the topics. In the long run, students will be encouraged to publish their research results in domestic and international academic journals and become members of the academic community. There are five main contents in this course: First, students will recognize the paradigms of research as well as the theoretical and scientific spirit of research. Second, students will understand the body of knowledge and research methodology of each research field. Third, students will develop the uniqueness and creativity of their own research through guided readings of their respective flagship academic journals. Fourth, students will understand the technique of reviewing academic journal articles. Finally, students will formulate a "doctoral dissertation" project idea that has the potential to contribute to their respective fields.
