二、評量標準：

（一）平時成績：60%

1. 平時paper閱讀口頭報告、分享、討論：

第3~13週（共9個報告週次）為同學帶領paper閱讀時間。導讀者可以選擇準備ppt或講義協助帶領討論過程，無硬性規定。重點是做paper簡介並點出研究問題核心、進行評論並帶領深入討論，老師會在過程中及最後進行回饋與講評。

每人負責口頭報告約三篇。
