Assessment 1: Presentation (weighting 30% of total assessment)

Every student would be assigned some academic papers related to accounting information systems. Every student should present the assigned academic papers during the specified week.

Your presentation file (PPT file) should be sent to e-learning platform before the presentation date.

Assessment 2: Midterm Exam (weighting 20% of total assessment)

A midterm examination will be held during the semester period. The make-up test will not be granted unless you can justify your absence.

Assessment 3: Final Exam (weighting 30% of total assessment)

A final examination will be held at the end of this semester. The make-up test will not be granted unless you can justify your absence.

Assessment 4: Speech Participation (weighting 20% of total assessment)

Some speeches will be held during this semester. Each student must sign in each speech and hand over a one-page report at the end of the speech.

The final grade for each student will be based on his/her cumulative score in each of the above areas of assessment. Students must satisfactorily complete all major tasks in order to pass this course.
