課程大綱  
Course Outline

This course explores regional development and resource governance as socially embedded, politically contested, and historically situated processes. Drawing on the disciplines of anthropology, geography, political economy, and development studies, this course will examine how regional politics, natural resources, and development agendas are shaped by power, knowledge, and institutions across multiple scales. Key themes include development thinking, resource governance, human-nature relations, energy politics, and the roles of the state and other actors in development planning. Through global case studies, the course critically investigates how development projects intersect with global politics, Indigenous rights, and environmental justice, highlighting how resource regimes are negotiated, contested, and reconfigured in practice.
