<p>This is an introductory course in macroeconomics. It focuses on helping students to understand the basic principles of macroeconomics and the applications of theories in daily life. Basically, macroeconomics examines the functioning of the economy as a whole, and it looks at how large components of an economy operates. Thus, we will discuss macro-relevant issues such as national income/consumption, government expenditure, unemployment, inflation, interest rates and balance of payment and many others. After learning these topics, you will be much better equipped to anticipate and to deal with large system-wide changes in market conditions.
