課程描述 Course Description					
<p>This course prepares students for the knowledge and practices regarding tourism and recreation impacts including economic, environmental, and socio-cultural aspects. Both theoretical and practical perspective of impacts will be addressed, and the lecture will be particularly focused on natural resource tourism and recreation impacts. Additionally, the approach of human dimensions for conservation and sustainability will be discussed for tourism and recreation impacts. Students will have the opportunity to choose a relevant tourism and recreation impact topic, detail the positive and negative impacts, make assessment for the impacts, promote the positive impacts, and provide possible solution for the negative impacts via completing a final team project. Students will possess the ability to deal with tourism and recreation impacts after taken this course.</p>					
課程目標 Course Objectives					
<p>任何土地利用形式均會對環境造成某種程度之衝擊，遊憩使用亦不例外。國民對戶外遊憩需求日殷，尤其是政府積極發展遊憩與自然文化觀光之下，遊憩與觀光之發展對現有之自然、社會、經濟與文化環境將促成改變。遊憩區或是觀光景點的經營不能，實際上也無法規避遊憩衝擊，唯有了解衝擊機制及可能的影響因子，來規劃與經營遊憩據點以及管理遊客，使得衝擊減至最低程度。</p> <p>本課程將從遊憩衝擊與觀光衝擊兩個層面了解人類遊憩使用與觀光行為所造成之自然、社會、經濟與文化的影響。使得學習者修完此課程後具備遊憩與觀光衝擊之基本知識，以及了解透過規劃、經營與監測而能對衝擊加以控制。在遊憩衝擊部分將包括遊憩衝擊之組成，影響衝擊之因子，遊憩衝擊經營之策略，遊憩衝擊之監測。在觀光衝擊部分則包括實質環境衝擊，經濟衝擊，社會與文化衝擊，觀光真實性的議題。</p>
