課程描述 Course Description	It is believed that regionalism is a decisive factor to realize peaceful and stable order via cooperation among countries in one region (Wunderlich, 2008). Ever since 1990s, East Asia has witnessed a rapid growth of regional integration activities, both in the scope and depth. Not only the institutions and mechanisms, but also the ideas and norms underpinning the development are important to study the process of regional integration in East Asia. By addressing the how (institutions and mechanisms) and why (ideas and norms) questions, this course will provide an overview of the key factors influencing the development of East Asia regional integration since the 1990s. It begins with discussing about the key concepts behind the theories of globalization, regionalism, and governance. In this theoretical part, European Union will be taken as a benchmark for studying as well as comparing regional integration theory and process. After the theoretical foundation, the course will empirically review the earlier models of regional integration in Asia and then moving to the present to examine the role of substantial institutions such as ASEAN+1 and ASEAN+3, EAS, ARF, APEC, TPP, RCEP and so on. Moreover, the role of key actors (extra- and intra-regional) and sub-regional processes in Asia will be investigated. Towards the end of the course, it will plan to engage students innovatively in a simulation on a regional issue. This aims to provide intellectual space for students to discover by themselves how regional politics may operate to find solutions to real-world problems.				

課程目標 Course Objectives	The course aims at presenting an analysis of the Asian approach to regionalism, review recent trends of regional cooperation and integration indicators, and analyze Asia's institutional architecture for regionalism. By focusing on the development of East Asian regional integration, it will help students to gain enough knowledge to understand and critically reflect various fundamental issues as well as the development characteristics of the region. In brief, through the course, students will be able to identify the characteristics and model of Asian regionalism and governance, which paves the path to build the further broader knowledge of comparative regionalism. This course expects to develop students' abilities to think and analyze regional issues critically, without digressing from the context of East Asian unique experiences of developing regional integration.

Mid-term:

Based on the knowledge from course session and their comprehension of the topics, they are asked to write one review report/commentary up to 2000 words. For the short review/commentary, it expects students to read reports, journal articles or other academic works (from or beyond the reading lists) about the integration in East Asia and Europe; and formulate their critical reflections on the relations between regional integration and global governance, between East Asian and European experiences.

Students can also choose one regional organization (ASEAN, Mercosur, SAARC, etc.) in the globe to analyze (genesis, evolution, structure, institutional design, main actors) and build one structure article.

Final:

A well written and structured academic paper (includes research questions and theoretical framework) is required. The specific topic will be discussed in the course.
