1 、 Requirements :

1. Attendance is important. Please attend the class on time. **(Start with 8. Absent = -3, late =-1. Full time attendance=+2. Email is required for asking a day off.)**
2. Whenever we finish a lesson, there will be a quiz in the next week. **Makeup quiz is not acceptable.**
3. Homework should be handed in on time.
4. The final exam includes listening test, reading test and written test. **No makeup exam is acceptable.**
5. You have to complete **two** language tasks in this semester: 1) a Chinese short film which performs the textbook dialogue or script written by yourself(**preferable**). 2) a 3-5 minute **oral presentation** (video recording) in the topic of **My Future Job** in Chinese.
6. **About Chinese characters:** You are required to read, write and type every character that appear in the textbook. There won't be practice sheet any more.

2 、 Notices:

1. You don't get extra points for doing homework and you don't lose points for not doing it. However, doing homework helps you improve your Chinese ability. Usually students who do their homework learn better than those who don't. **Don't copy homework from your classmates.** You are just wasting your time.
2. I don't accept digital homework because I can't correct it. If you use a digital workbook, you have to print out your homework by yourself.
3. When you make the PowerPoint for the oral presentation, you have to write your original content. Copying another student's content is not allowed.
4. Attendance is important. If you don't have an ideal final score, usually it's because your attendance is bad.
5. **I will NEVER accept any negotiation for scores.** If you need a high score, work hard to earn it.

About the Oral Presentation “My Future Job”:

1. You have to finish this on time.
2. Please do a ppt slides to make your presentation more interesting.
3. **NEVER** use google translation based on 2 reasons: 1) you don't practice anything. 2) Google translation is **ALWAYS** wrong. However, you can use it for looking for vocabulary that you need to express.
4. Please only use the Chinese you know to make this presentation. **DO NOT** use too difficult language structure. You may fail to present it in a proper way. Difficult sentences don't make your presentation better.
5. You **HAVE TO** write some Chinese sentences in the PPT. I will evaluate your typing skill.
6. In your presentation, you should include the following contents:
 - 1) Your ideal job in the future.
 - 2) The ability to do this job.
 - 3) The reason why you want to do this job.
 - 4) The pros and cons of this job.
 - 5) Your opinion about this job.
 - 6) Last comment.
7. Please do this in **traditional characters**.
8. Adding some pictures or drawings will be a plus.
9. Record your presentation to a video. Upload it to YouTube and send me the link **before the deadline**. Late submission will get **10% score deduction**.
10. Your presentation will be graded based on: 1) the fluency, 2) the accuracy (e.g. good pronunciation and tones, no wrong characters, no grammar mistakes, etc.), 3) the content.
11. **NEVER** use AI to generate your oral presentation. This is a language class, not a computer science class.
