課程描述 Course Description

A. The goal/outline of the course:

Students will learn English through the critical evaluation of popular music specially selected by for its richness of expression and narrative lyrical content. Students will analyze and discuss their impressions and interpretations of songs presented in class, and will broaden their English vocabularies and enrich their critical thinking skills in the process. Songs will be taken from the canons of such notable musical luminaries of Western music as Bob Dylan, Neil Young, Gordon Lightfoot, Tom Petty, Paul Simon, and others.

B. The teaching methods:

The first hour of class will be student presentations. In the second hour, the teacher will lecture and we will have class discussions. Prior to hearing a song, students will be introduced to key vocabulary and its usage. While listening to the songs introduced in class, students are encouraged to simultaneously read along with the lyrics. Following this, the class will engage in analysis and discussion of the song's content and meaning, including: theme, imagery, mood, characters, setting, story line, use of literary devices, rhyme, phrasing etc. Students will be expected to think analytically and critically, and to articulate their opinions and impressions in English. Only material covered by the instructor in the listening, lecture, and discussion portions class of our class is testable (i.e. students will not be tested on the content of their classmates' presentations)

STUDENT SONG PRESENTATIONS

Each student will give one individual report on a song of his or her choice, including a brief introduction to the artist, an analysis of the song's lyrics and meaning, as well as identifying and explaining difficult vocabulary. The presentation should be approximately fifteen minutes in length, and should be prepared using PPT or other appropriate software with all references clearly cited.

Please be ready to present at your time on your date.

Students will not be tested on the content of other students' presentations.

C. Important notes:

No phone use / eating /sleeping allowed in class.

All your work must be your own original writing. There are no exceptions. Students caught plagiarizing will receive a mark of zero on the assignment. The instructor's policy on the use of AI to complete students'

song presentations will be explained in class. Song presentations must represent completely original

work and cannot be copied in whole or in part from sources or prepared using AI technology. If the instructor has any doubt that a student has failed to comply with this requirement, the corpus text of the student's presentation will be run through an AI detector tool (ChatGPT Zero). If the results of this check indicate a strong likelihood or greater that AI was used to write the content, significant deductions will be made to the students' scores at the instructor's discretion. Students taking this class must agree to conform to this policy.
