其他補充說明 (Supplemental instructions)

1 x 15-minute presentation in English on different aspects of British life, culture and current events in the UK based around UK news stories. Each week, there will be 3-4 presentations from 3-4 students on a similar theme. Any references and material must be properly cited in their presentations. Reading will not be permitted. For the presentations, students must also prepare a list of questions related to the subject of their presentations for their classmates to discuss. The power point as well as the list of questions must be emailed to me several days before the day of the presentation with sources and questions for the audience. I also want you to nominate some classmates to answer your questions if nobody volunteers to answer them! No plagiarizing from the internet! There will also be short quizzes for homework after we finish a chapter in class.

In addition, students are required to make a short presentation of a song (5 minutes) by a UK (or Irish) singer or band. Introduce the song or band, then play the song showing the class the MV and lyrics. Prepare one question about your song and nominate someone in class to answer it!

Students are expected to attend classes every week. If students wish to take time off, they must request a leave of absence online before the class and email me as well. If students are ill, they should email me. They will then be excused. If students take leave without permission or without being unwell, they will lose 20% from their attendance grade. Four absences for whatever reason will result in the student failing the class automatically.

Students (and teachers) are expected to arrive on time for class. Classes start at ten past the hour and attendance will be taken at the beginning of each class. If students are not present when their name is called, they will lose 5% from their attendance grade each time they are late. If they arrive 30 minutes after class starts, they will be marked as absent. Please do not speak Chinese in class or sleep. Also do not eat or bring food into class. Phones, tablets and laptops are strictly forbidden for the duration of the class but can be used in the 2x10 minutes of break time. Please bring a pen and notebook to every class for making notes. Attendance will begin from week 3, but if students sign up in weeks 1 and 2 and do not attend, they will be marked as absent or may be asked to drop the class if the class is over subscribed. If you are graduating this semester, please give me time to enter your grades. Please note that when you email me your PPT or if you wish to communicate with me, clearly write your English name and which class you are in.

This class is designated as face to face on campus but we may have to have an online class or even an exam, due to weather, teacher being sick, or a natural disaster. If this is the case, please check your equipment and make sure that your camera, microphone and speakers are working properly. When presenting or listening, please make sure that your entire face is visible, facing the front, you're not backlit, and that you are ready to participate just as if we were having physical class.
